Colonel Ken Dyer is a native of Cleveland, OH. He entered the Army in 1984 by enlisting in the Pennsylvania National Guard. In 1986, he graduated from Mercyhurst College, Erie, PA and was commissioned in the Regular Army as a Second Lieutenant in the Quartermaster Corps.
