



Captain Wink reports to Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Southwest as the Executive Officer from Amphibious Construction Battalion ONE in Coronado, CA where he was the Commanding Officer. Currently he is temporarily assigned as the Joint Task Force-Haiti J7 in Port-au-Prince.

He was commissioned in 1986 through the Naval Reserve Officer Training Corps at the University of Rochester where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Chemical Engineering. He also holds a Master of Science Degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Maryland, is an alumnus of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology Seminar XXI Program, and has completed the Kellogg Advanced Executive Program at Northwestern University. Captain Wink is a qualified Seabee Combat Warfare Officer, a member of the Acquisition Professional Community, and a registered Professional Engineer in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
