

Major General Blalock serves in the Alabama Joint Force Headquarters as Adjutant General of the Alabama National Guard. In this capacity, he is responsible for providing support to all Army and Air Guard units in the state in training, administration, logistics, supply, maintenance and other applicable programs or functions. He was assigned to this position by Alabama Governor Bob Riley in August 2007.

Prior to becoming Adjutant General, he had been assigned as Commander of the 167th Theater Sustainment Command in Birmingham. This command is a Theater level headquarters with more than 350 personnel assigned that provides operational logistical command and control for Northern Command. General Blalock was commissioned in March 1971 after completing ROTC at Virginia Military Institute and Auburn University. His early Guard assignments were in the 31st Armored Brigade (Separate). He has served as Commander of an Infantry Company, a Heavy Support Battalion, an Area Support Group and a Chemical Brigade.
