Kochanek, MD, is Professor and Vice Chairman of Critical Care Medicine and Director of the Safar Center for Resuscitation Research at the University of Pittsburgh. He has a track-record of investigation in traumatic and ischemic brain injury and neurointensive care and is funded by the NIH, the US Army, DARPA, and Laerdal Foundation. He is a Site-PI on both the DARPA-funded PREVENT blast program and a US Army-funded collaborative project with the Brain Dysfunction and Blast Injury Program at WRAIR on traumatic brain injury resuscitation. He is Co-PI of the University of Pittsburgh Brain Trauma Research Center. He is also PI of a T-32 titled "Pediatric Neurointensive Care and Resuscitation

Research" and has mentored numerous trainees. He is Editor-in-Chief of Pediatric Critical Care Medicine, Director of Pediatric Critical Care Medicine Research, and is Associate Director of the Clinical Translational Research Center at Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh. He received the Distinguished Investigator Award from the American College of Critical Care Medicine in 2007, the Critical Care Distinguished Career Award from the American Academy of Pediatrics in 2008, and gave the Baaken Lecture at the Cleveland Clinic in 2008.
